EDUCATION:

\$550,000 invested in 23 programs at 17 agencies supporting quality child care, school readiness and academic completion.

Success By 6 (preparing children to enter school ready to succeed)

INCOME:

\$350,000 invested in 14 programs at 10 agencies to support job skills, affordable housing, skills for increased savings, financial assets and long term stability.

Emergency Food and Shelter Program (support for emergency shelter, food pantries, rent/mortgage assistance, utility assistance received from FEMA)

Operation Helping Hand (Food Drives to support local pantries)

Connections (Human Services Resource Directory)

Gifts In-Kind (Items donated through a network of stores to support agencies and clients – over \$400,000 value in 2008)

Tax Prep & EITC (On-line and On-site Tax Preparation for persons making less than \$52,000 per year, and on-site prep for child care workers)



HEALTH:

FY 2008 investments of over \$600,000 to 17 programs provided by 13 agencies to support health services, access to healthcare, violence prevention, and coordination of services.
