EDUCATION:
\$550,000 invested in 23 programs at 17 agencies supporting quality child care, school readiness and academic completion.

- Success By 6 (preparing children to enter school ready to succeed)
- PA Pre-K Counts Program (Quality Pre-K Classes)
- 21st Century Learning Grant (Afterschool & Summer Programs in Bristol Borough)

INCOME:
\$350,000 invested in 14 programs at 10 agencies to support job skills, affordable housing, skills for increased savings, financial assets and long term stability.

- Operation Helping Hand (Food Drives to support local pantries)

In 2008, United Way brought over \$850,000 in State and Federal Grants to Bucks County; providing high quality Pre-K for families in need, training teachers to identify signs of abuse and neglect, helping to reduce drug, alcohol and tobacco use in youth, and more.

United Way also helped companies and individuals give over \$400,000 of "In-Kind" gifts. We work with area companies to convert their excess stock of items, ranging from coats to cookware, into real impact that makes a difference in people's lives.

Additionally, the FamilyWise/United Way Prescription Discount Program saved Bucks County residents over \$236,000 on their prescriptions. This program is for people who do not have prescription coverage or are required to pay for a drug that is not covered on their current plan.
