- Please <u>click here</u> to enroll your interest. A member of our engagement team will contact you within 24 hours to register your child and confirm qualification of employment. Registration interest form must be submitted by each Saturday (prior to the Monday start), 12PM.
- Also, please <u>click here</u> to complete the required paperwork. This paperwork will be needed and reviewed upon drop off. Please allow for extra time on your first day for this review to occur. All parents/guardians will need to show work ID upon entry into the program.
- This program is strictly for medical professionals, essential employees and first responders.

Safety and health precautions: Our ratio for this program will be 1 instructor to 5 children. All children and adults will be screened for fever at drop off each day. Facilities will be cleaned throughout the program and upon closure. Social distancing practices will occur at all times. Handwashing will occur continually throughout the day. Also, in following CDC guidelines: Please do not enroll or bring your child if any member of the household has a fever or signs and symptoms of flu, severe cold or other illness including vomiting or chills and/or if any member of the household has traveled to a high risk country within 14 days. Any child with a cough (regardless of fever) will not be accepted into the program.
