Customizable benefits, including volunteer opportunities to unpack and sort your sponsored pallets or truck, are available.

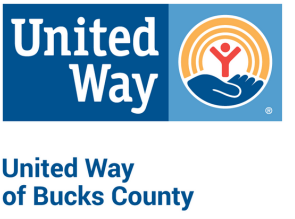
