## **About Private Scholarships**

Thanks to generous donors and the Pennsylvania Educational Improvement Tax Credit (EITC) program, United Way of Bucks County is able to provide pre-k scholarships to low- and moderate-income families. In partnership with 6 high-quality pre-k programs, UW Bucks provides scholarships to families who live in Bucks County and meet certain eligibility criteria. Below is the information you need to apply for a scholarship.



## **Eligibility**

Children who meet the following criteria are eligible for EITC and private scholarships:

- Child's Age: The child must be 3 or 4 years old by August 31, 2022
- Residency: The family must live in Bucks County
- Family Income: May not exceed \$96,676 plus \$17,017 for each dependent (as defined by the IRS).

- 2. Submit the completed application and supporting documents to your preferred program below.
