**Must be a Bucks County resident at/or below the 300% Federal Poverty Level.**

-  Combined monthly income can not exceed:
- 1 person household - \$3,645/monthly
  - 2 person household - \$4,930/monthly
  - 3 person household - \$6,215/monthly

**Registration can be completed online or on site**

One sign up per household.   
One pick up per week.
